



# Useful Information

## VISITATION RISK ACKNOWLEDGMENT AGREEMENT

BY SIGNING THE AGREEMENT, YOU DECLARE THAT YOU ARE AWARE THAT EVERY ECOTOURISM ACTIVITY HAS RISKS AND THAT YOU WILL BE IN A PLACE WHERE FIRST AID AND REMOVAL TAKE LONGER TIME.

- It is mandatory to comply with the safety guidelines presented by the reception staff and listed on this sign.
- Medical restrictions must be informed at reception to check if you are able to take the tour.
- When necessary, visitors must carry their own medication.

EVERY ACTIVITY IN CONTACT WITH NATURE OFFERS RISKS, SUCH AS:

- Sliding on rough terrain, rocks or on the suspended trail;
- Incidents resulting from water activities: drowning, hypothermia, ear problems, among others;
- Abrasions, cuts and scratches due to collision with stones and tree trunks;
- Attack by wild animals, insect bites and venomous animals;
- Weather, lightning, wind, falling trees, among others;
- Breakdown and/or loss of equipment.

## FIRST AID

In case of an accident, follow the guidelines below:

- 1- Check the security of the location and calm the victim;
  - 2- Assess the state of the victim (Codes below);
  - 3- Check the need to ask for support;
  - 4- Call reception and speak calmly and clearly.
- Report the victim's condition and specify the location.



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**SAVE THE CONTACT**

There is cellphone signal in most part of the trails (Vivo operator).

## VICTIM ASSESSMENT

### GREEN CODE Stable victim

Nausea, malaise, tiredness, cold, scratches, small cuts.

Can walk.

### CODE YELLOW Stable victim

With a lot of pain (sprain, fracture, onset of hypothermia).

Requires medical attention and/or removal with a board.

### CODE RED Unstable victim

Life risk! Unconscious, open fracture, hemorrhage, hypothermia.

Needs immediate removal. Activate Ambulance.
